“25th Australian Deaf Golf Championships to be held in Launceston Tasmania 14-16 April 2019”

Deaf Golf Australia (DGA) is delighted announce the 25th Australian Deaf Golf Championships (ADGC) will be held at Country Club Tasmania’s golf course facility over three days 14-16 April 2019.

The 54-hole event will attract a number of golfers from around Australia representing a number of States and Territories. This will be the selection trials for the Australian Team to participate in the next World Deaf Golf Championships in 2020, at Forest of Arden near Birmingham, England.

Golflink handicaps range from +2.7 to 28+ and all golfers with a hearing loss of at least 55 decibels in the better ear are invited to participate in the event. In 2019, we will see the introduction of two more categories to the event: Ladies’ Seniors and Juniors (under 18 years) :-

- Juniors (under 18 years) – **New category**
- Ladies’
- Ladies’ Seniors (over 50 years) – **New category**
- Men’s
- Men’s Seniors (over 50 years)

DGA wishes to acknowledge the key supporters of the event - Golf Tasmania, Golf Australia, Deaf Sports Australia, Country Club Tasmania and Golf brands including Callaway & Srixon.

DGA has a proud history of hosting the National Championships in different states since it was inaugurated in 1970. As a result we have produced men and women Australian World Champions at the World Deaf Golf Championships over the years.
