## BREAKING NEWS!!

We are delighted to announce that Golf Tasmania has successfully applied to the Tasmanian Government on our behalf for a grant for our upcoming Championships at Country Club Tasmania 14-16 April. A sum total of \$3,000 has been granted to help with the costs of running the event. The committee will be using the funds to subsidise the costs of tournament entry fees. Once the costs and expenses of the three day event are finalised (most probably after the conclusion of the Championships) we will be offering each golfer the choice of a small or partial refund or donate to the Deaf Golf Australia Development fund for the team to Birmingham in 2020. The final dollar amount of the refund will depend on the following factors:-

- The number of entries into the tournament – please don't delay your entry – do it today if you haven't done so already ☺
- Final costs of running the 3 day event including the green fees and trophy costs etc.
- Additional sponsorship grants from other corporations to our event
